8.1 Safety

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8.2 Swap Berth Licences of the same size & value

The berth licence holders of two 12m berths wish to swap (by official transfer) their licences. The licences hold exactly the same value, the swap/transfer does not negatively affect or impact anyone else (e.g. waiting listees). The Marina Committee agreed that this transfer could occur subject to mutual agreement, the completion of paperwork & receipt of the administration charge.

8.3 Licensees able to occupy alternative berths subject to mutual & Marina Committee agreement

Berth licensees are able by mutual & Marina Committee agreement to occupy each other's licenced berths in the situation where the vessels owned by the licensees are better located in the alternate berths. For example, smaller vessel in the smaller berth & larger vessel in the larger berth. This agreement is at the discretion of the Marina Manager & is not a permanent arrangement & in no way circumvents the berth licence waiting lists. If one of the licences involved is sold the arrangement will immediately cease & the marina will attempt to relocate the affected vessel however this is not guaranteed.
