# **Notice of Race**

#### 1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* 2009-2012.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part II, Category 5 shall apply to keel yachts and multihulls.
- 1.3 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part V, Category C shall apply to Trailer Yachts and Sports Trailer Yachts.
- 1.4 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part VI, Category B shall apply to Sport Boats.
- 1.5 The International Flying Fifteen Association Class Rules shall apply.
- 1.6 The required safety gear must be carried on board at all times and may be inspected.

# 2 Changes to the Racing Rules

- The Rules will be modified in accordance with Rule 86 Changes to the Racing Rules as follows:-
- 2.1 For any protest where only a rule of Part 2 is alleged to have been broken, an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing. YNZ regulations part 4.5.5 applies.
- 2.2 Rule 44.1 *Taking a Penalty* is changed so that the 720° turn is replaced by a 360° turn.
- 2.3 Rules 51 Setting and Sheeting Sails and 52 Manual Power are modified to allow nominated boats i.e. [A Canting Keel], [Water Ballast Tanks] with movable Ballast to compete. Boats must comply with ISAF Appendix K [www.sailing.org] and Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations clause 6 [www.yachtingnz.org.nz]. TCF's may be altered accordingly.

# 3 Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all: Keelboats, Multihulls, Open Keel Yachts, Sports Boats, Trailer Yachts, and Sports Trailer Yachts.
- 3.2 Series entries will be accepted prior to the first race by completing the entry form accompanied by a fee of \$40 and forwarding it to The Keel Boat Committee, Kerikeri Cruising Club Inc, 346 Opito Bay Road, R D 1, Kerikeri.
- 3.3 Individual race entries will be accepted prior to the KCC five-minute signal of that entry's Division.
- 3.4 Individual race entry is available on the entry sheet in the start box. An entry fee of \$5.00 per Handicap system applies and must be paid before the race prize giving starts.
- 3.5 Individual race entries will be accepted by VHF Channel 77 or phone (407 9434) prior to the KCC five-minute signal of that entry's Division.
- 3.6 To be eligible to compete in this series, the entrant's helmsperson shall be a full financial member of the KCC.
- 3.7 Individual race entries from visiting yachts will be accepted if the entrant's helmsperson is a full financial member of a yacht club affiliated to YNZ.

## 4 Racing Schedule:

- 4.1 Two divisions as per the Sailing Instruction will be raced.
- 4.2 The racing schedule is as follows

#### 8 Prizes

- 8.1 Prize giving on each race night will be held no sooner than 1 hour after the last yacht has crossed the finish line.
- 8.2 Visiting Yacht entries are eligible for Race Prizes.
- 8.3 Visiting Yacht entries are not eligible for Club Trophies.
- 8.4 The following prizes shall be awarded:
  - One dozen bottles of beer for the winner of each division on the day, plus a six-pack for 2nd & 3rd in each division.
    - If there are sufficient entries a drawn prize will be given
  - Willis Sails half price sail. Drawn at end of year prize giving. Boats must complete at least 7 races to qualify; each race entry earns an entry in the prize draw.
