



Kerikeri Cruising Club, Learn to Sail for registered adults and children, welcomes the involvement of families of the LTS students in the sailing sessions.

The following is a list of roles and expectations that the LTS programs require from parents/caregivers of school aged children on the courses.

Please be present at the beginning and before the end of each session to support your child with the following -

General Roles for each LTS day

Ensure that your child signs in and reports to the coach.

Ensure that your child has a well fitting life jacket, these are available to use.

Help to bring boats and rigging out with your child in a safe manner.

The expectation is that the children learn to rig their own boat but they may need some help initially – the coaches can guide you.

Help to launch boats, when instructed by the coaches and park trailers on the shore.

Help to bring the boats in, sponge out water, wipe down and return boats, trailers and rigging to their storage sites.

Return life jackets.

Ensure your child has signed out.

You are welcome to discuss your child's achievements with our coaches.

Each week help is also required for the running of the session, please check with the designated 'beach warden', of the day, if the following specific roles have been filled for the session and share the responsibility of the roles with other parents/caregivers over the term-

Specific Roles for each LTS day

1 Paperwork help.

An adult to ensure that all children have signed in and then signed out from the water.

2 Coach boats.

Help is required to launch and return the coach boats, off and on the trailers, in and out of storage.

LTS needs at least one other adult (**more are welcome!**) in addition to the coach for each coach boat in order to safely supervise the students out on the water.

Life jackets must be worn on the coach boats and are available in the shed.

If you have siblings of students with you they are welcome on the coach boats too.

3 If you are a sailor and would like to help coach please approach one of the coaches about what role would be best for you.
