Venue, Dove's Bay

1, Aims a, To provide an interesting fairly informal sailing event building on the success of our last efforts.

b, Encourage some of our 'youth' and other skippers to act as leaders in a team sailing format.

c, Invite neighbouring clubs to join in a friendly inter club cooperative sailing format.

2 Rules, RRS, 2021 – 2024 inc. appendix D will apply

3 Format, Boats [2 handed] will be sorted into reasonably = teams of 3 with at least one knowledgeable skipper. Each team **MUST HAVE** at least one **ADULT SAILOR!** [over @ 30 yrs.] [1 point extra overall for 2 or more adults. Three helms, and three crews sail as a team around short, <10 minute, courses against other teams [one pair of teams at a time in a round robin format. ] The course will be a starboard hand 'square' around the start finish boat off Dove's Bay

4, Programme, 9.00 am, Meet at Dove's Bay - complete rigging boats.

9.30 am, Briefing.

10.00 am, Start first Round Robin draw, continue as long as sailors want to.

4.00 pm. Racing finishes

4.30 pm. End of event.

5, The draw will depend on the number of teams who enter. If 6 teams enter, a draw will consist of 15 races, each team will sail 5 races per draw. When not racing they will be able to watch and cheer on the racing teams.

6, Cost. \$15 per 'family' or \$10 per individual to cover use of dinghies and patrol boats.

7, Entries / invitation, the event is open to sailors of all ages from Auckland, North Yacht Clubs. Sailors need to be dressed in sensible sailing clothes, including Buoyancy aid. Teams will be identified by colours. Supporters are welcome. A variety of boats may be used but 420s are planned.
