# Notice of Race

### 1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* 2009-2012.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part II, Category 4 shall apply to keel yachts and multihulls.
- 1.3 A life raft or approved dinghy is recommended race 1 & 2 and required for race 3 plus life Lines.
- 1.4 Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part V, Category A shall apply for trailer yachts.
- 1.5 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part VI, Category A shall apply for sportboats.
- 1.6 The required safety gear must be carried on board at all times and may be inspected.
- 1.7 Refer to the BOIYC NOR and race 3 entry forms (attached) for race 3 in this series.
- 1.8 Self-steering devices are permissible only where fewer than three people are aboard a yacht.

### 2 Rating System

- 2.1 General Handicap, PHRF and IRC will be used for this series.

### 3 Changes to the Racing Rules: The Rules will be modified in accordance with Rule 86 as follows:-

- 3.1 For any protests where only a rule of Part 2 is alleged to have been broken, an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing. YNZ regulations part 4.5.5 applies.
- 3.2 Rule 44.1 is changed so that the 720° turn is replaced by a 360° turn.
- 3.3 Rules 51 & 52 are modified to allow nominated boats i.e. canting keel, water or moveable ballast to compete. Boats must comply with ISAF Appendix K [[www.sailing.org](http://www.sailing.org)] and Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations clause 6 [[www.yachtingnz.org.nz](http://www.yachtingnz.org.nz)]. TCF'S may be altered accordingly.
- 3.4 Rule 52 *Manual Power* shall not apply.

### 4 Eligibility and Entry

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all keelboats, multihulls, open keel yachts, sports boats, trailer yachts and sports trailer yachts.
- 4.2 Individual race entries will be accepted prior to the KCC five minute signal of that entry's Division for races 1 & 2, and prior to the start of the BOIYC's Whangaroa race.
- 4.3 Individual race entry is available on the entry sheet in the start box. A KCC entry fee of \$5.00 per series race applies, in addition to the entry fee for race 3 in this series as required by the BOIYC.
- 4.4 Individual race entries will be accepted by VHF or phone (407 9434) prior to the KCC five minute signal of that entry's start.
- 4.5 To be eligible to compete in this event series, the entrant's helmsperson shall be a full financial member of KCC.
- 4.6 Individual race entries from visiting Yachts will be accepted if the entrant's Helmsperson is a full financial member of an affiliated Yacht Club.
- 4.7 This is a one division race.

## 5 Racing Schedule:

5.1 The Racing scheduled is as follows

## 6 Re run of races

6.1 The race organisers reserve the right to re-run any postponed or abandoned races. Any rescheduling will be notified on the club website and clubroom notice board not less than 4 days before it will take effect.

## 7 Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be made available on the KCC website ([www.kerikericruisingclub.org.nz](http://www.kerikericruisingclub.org.nz)) and in the start box.

## 8 Racing Area

The races will be held in the area of the Bay of Islands and extended to include the Cavalli Islands and to Whangaroa.

## 9 Courses to be sailed

Refer Appendix A of the Sailing Instructions.

## 10 Scoring

10.1 The Low Point scoring System of Appendix A of the *Racing Rules of Sailing* 2009-2012 will apply.

10.2 Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10.3 When three races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## 11 Prizes

11.1 Prize giving on each race day will be held no sooner than 30 minutes after the last yacht has crossed the finish line, except for race 3 when prizes will be awarded at the first available opportunity.

11.2 Visiting yacht entries are eligible for race prizes

11.3 Visiting yacht entries are not eligible for club trophies.

11.4 The following handicap prizes shall be awarded:

1<sup>st</sup> Bottle of rum, 2<sup>nd</sup> one dozen beer, 3<sup>rd</sup> 6 pack of beer.
