Notice of Race

Open to members of any yacht club in the Bay of Islands

PREAMBLE: This event is a three race series, each race being hosted by a different club in the Bay of Islands.

This document serves as a precursor to the event and may be replaced by host club documents prior to each race in this series.

1 Rules

- 1.1 The race will be governed by the "Rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017–2020 (RRS).
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part II Category 5 shall apply to keelboats and multihulls.
- 1.3 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part V Category C shall apply to trailer yachts.
- 1.4 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part VI Category B shall apply to sport boats.
- 1.5 All other yachts shall comply with their appropriate class and safety rules.
- 1.6 Every yacht shall have on board a functioning VHF radio plus two red and two orange flares (all less than three years old), all of which are readily accessible.
- 1.7 The required safety gear must be carried on board at all times and may be inspected for compliance with the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.8 RRS 51 *Moveable Ballast* is modified to allow yachts with moveable/variable ballast systems and/or canting keels to compete. Yachts shall comply with ISAF Special Regulations Appendix K and YNZ Safety Regulations 6.1(k) and 6.2(k).
- 1.9 RRS Rule 52 *Manual Power* shall not apply.
- 1.10 Between Sunset and Sunrise the "International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea" will apply, replacing the relevant rules of Racing Rules of Sailing Part 2.
- 11.11 The Sailing Instructions may also change other RRS.

2 Scoring

- 2.1 General Handicap and PHRF Inshore corrected times will be recorded.
- 2.2 General Handicap time correction factors used will previously have been agreed to by competing Bay of Islands clubs.

3 Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The race is open to all keelboats and multihulls that meet the requirements of clause 1.2, to trailer yachts that meet the requirements of Clause 1.3, to sport boats that meet the requirements of Clause 1.4 and to all other yachts that meet the requirements of Clause 1.5.
- 3.2 Race entries from eligible boats will be accepted by VHF channel 77, or by sailing in the vicinity of the start line, prior to the race's five minute warning signal.
- 3.3 The entrant's helmsperson shall be a current full financial member of a yacht club affiliated to Yachting New Zealand

5 Racing Area

All races will be held in the area of the Bay of Islands with start lines the vicinity of Brampton Buoy and finish lines off each race's host club.

7 Prizes

- 7.1 The prize giving for each race will be held in the host club following that race.
- 7.2 The series prize giving will be held in the Kerikeri Cruising Club following racing on March 31st.
- 7.3 All yacht entries are eligible for race prizes, including the Epiglass Bay of Islands Interclub Cup which will be presented to the winning club at the conclusion of the series.
